The Duszak Family is proud to announce their 2nd Annual Computerized Christmas Light Show.

Opening night is Monday NOV 30th at 6:00 PM.
Shows will run daily from 6 PM-10 PM NOV 30th through JAN 10, 2010 (weather permitting).

To experience the full effect, please tune your radio to 95.9 FM.

There are over 40,000 lights and over 300 computer controlled channels used to run the show. All the features and hardware are handmade. Computer software called Vixen (www.vixenlights.com) to program and control the lights in time to music.

"Ever since I was little I remember wanting to know how things worked. I'm sure a lot of people do, but I took it a little further then most. I have always enjoyed decorating for Christmas and a few years ago, I saw an email with lights that appeared to play in time to music. The next day I looked into figuring out if the display was real. When I found out it was, I wanted to figure out how it was done. I discovered that it was created using commercial hardware and software. When looking into what was used, I knew there had to be a cheaper alternative. I decided to research and build my own pic-based dimmers..... and I needed to build a lot of them!

I spent most of 2008 figuring out how to make the show work, building all the features and then programming it to run in time to music. I was building the show right up to opening day! And, although most of it had been tested and running, there were some components of the show being tested and tweaked until thirty minutes before opening night!

Not only did the show go off without a hitch, a fire truck happened to come through the development on opening carrying Santa!!! Everyone thought we set it up but it was just random luck!

Anyway, designing and creating the show is a lot of fun, but more time consuming then you can imagine. This is just one way I like to show my creativity and at the same time give something to a wonderful charity. With the approval of my wife, I hope to continue doing Bigger and Brighter shows in the years to come!" ~ Ron D. ~

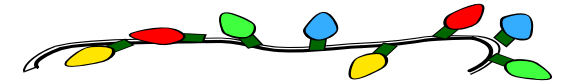
Krasley's Country Christmas

At the display you will see a sign showing the FM station to tune into in order to experience the full effect of the music in time with the light display.



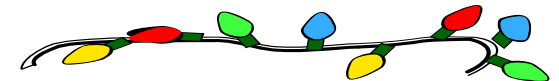
Boucher Lights
